

Location:

The international meeting will be held at the Ichijo Hall, Yayoi Auditorium, the University of Tokyo. The University of Tokyo (Yayoi Campus): 1-1-1 Yayoi, Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo 113-0032 JAPAN

The stations near the university are <u>Ueno</u> on the **JR Yamanote line**, <u>Ochanomizu</u> on the **JR Chuo line**, and <u>Keisei-Ueno</u> on the **Keisei line**. When you come from these stations, it is convenient to take a taxi. The nearest subway stations are <u>Todaimae</u> on the **Namboku line** and <u>Nezu</u> on the **Chiyoda line**. You can walk to the university from these subway stations.

Travel to the University From Narita Airport

It is most convenient to take a **Keisei line**_train from Narita airport. The destination would be the **Keisei-Ueno** station. It takes about one and a half hours from the airport to this station. On the same line, you can also take the Skyliner, where you could use some extra facilities, for example baggage rooms. You need an additional ticket to take the Skyliner.
